## Call for postdoctoral fellowships 2019

### ***About the position***

PEDECIBA calls for researchers in Math, Physics, Chemistry, Biosciences, Geosciences and Informatics interested in carrying out postdoctoral activities in Uruguay for a one-year period renewable for a second-year subject to the presentation of a research report and availability of funds. Applicants must have completed doctoral studies in the last 5 years before the date of the beginning of activities.

The position is full time (40 hours per week) and may only be compatible with up to 15 additional hours of teaching. These contracts are intended to support researchers who begin their postdoctoral work and who intend to carry out research activities in Uruguay. The call is open to PhDs of any nationality (including PEDECIBA researchers), who wish to participate in the academic and research activities of our community. The monthly salary before taxes will be UYU 89,347 or approximately USD 2500. In addition, a single payment of UYU 20,000 will be granted for research expenses.

### ***Candidates should submit:***

1. Full curriculum vitae.
2. A work plan endorsed by the supervisor who should be a PEDECIBA researcher and not have been the applicant PhD supervisor. The extension of the work plan must not exceed five A4 size pages (Arial 11, 1.5 line spacing) plus a reference section.
3. A declaration signed by the applicant of not having other remunerated activity, or only the compatible activity mentioned above, during the period of the postdoctoral contract.
4. Two letters of recommendation from academics familiar with the candidate previous activity and not from the proposed postdoctoral advisor.

*Applications submitted will be evaluated by an Advisory Committee appointed by PEDECIBA's Board of Directors. The documentation must be submitted by email to [posdoc@pedeciba.edu.uy](mailto:posdoc@pedeciba.edu.uy) until July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019.*
